1. On March 20, 2012 a group of social workers and community supporters have an event.
2. At the event using a projector display a split screen video of social problems alongside the professional social workers that address the social problem (see an example of a split screen video to use at http://youtu.be/oe4aAh9Zz_k).
3. The projection is on a wall or surface with permission that has meaning to social work and can be viewed by the public.
4. The event is video taped
5. The event video is uploaded to YouTube and shared at www.thesocialworkproject.org web site for all to view.
